

What to Bring

(We leave 1 roll of toilet paper in each bathroom & 1 trash bag in each can; Bring Extra)

Don't Forget to Bring:

- ✓ **BATH TOWELS, WASH RAGS, HAND TOWELS, RIVER TOWELS**
- ✓ **TOILET PAPER, TRASH BAGS - 13 gal. kitchen can, 39 gal. for outside cans**
- ✓ **GROCERIES & SUPPLIES**; salt, pepper, sugar, paper towels, Individual K-Cups
Or Drip coffee filters & coffee (we have both kinds of coffee makers).
dish soap, (dishwasher detergent Only if your rental has a dishwasher)
- ✓ **BATH ARTICLES**; shampoo, bath soap, hand soap, laundry soap (if has washer)
- ✓ **SUGGESTED ITEMS**; flashlight, batteries, matches, firewood if has wood
burning fireplace, lighter fluid & charcoal for grill, stereo/radio, camera, binoculars,
insect spray, sun block, hat, sunglasses, river chairs, river shoes, Fishing License.

***The Towers are AT&T - Only AT&T Cell Phones work here!**
